- * On February 28, 2019 will be a blessing and enthronement of the original image of Our Lord Jesus Christ's bust image "Ecce Homo" to its permanent urn.
- Veneration will follow after the Holy Mass and blessing.
 * There will be a short procession around the Pilgrim Center after the Fiesta Mass.

The bust image of the suffering Jesus entitled "Ecce Homo" depicts the moment our Lord was presented by Pontius Pilate to the crowd shouting the words "Ecce homol" (John 19:5) which means "behold the man!" It was answered with "Crucify Him! Crucify Him". In the long tradition in the Church, the meditation beholding the Holy Face of Jesus presented as sentenced to death for our sins, was so popular in the medieval age and reproduction of the sorrowful face of Jesus in painting and sculpture was common. The Basilica del Sto. Niño possesses a religious icon of "Ecce Homo" imbued with historical significance. It was accidentally discovered in a tomb of a local chieftain on August 20, 1572. Since then, it earned popular devotion of its own aside from the Sto. Niño de Cebu. However, the devotion faded out sometime after World War II. It was brought to Manila in 1965 but only returned to Cebu in 2011. Efforts have been made to revive the devotion and this first liturgical feast is part of it. Celebrating the feast within the established Church liturgical feast, we make the devotion closer to the spirit of Lent.

The traditional feast of the Holy Face of Jesus which falls on Shrove Tuesday (Tuesday before Ash Wednesday) was chosen by the Basilica del Santo Niño friars to be the feast of the Ecce Homo (March 5 this year). To prepare for the celebration, Novena Masses were held from February 24 to March 4, 2019 at the basilica. The basilica's different ministries and mandated organizations sponsored each day of the novena Masses.

On March 5, 2019, the Eucharistic celebration was presided by Fr. Ric Anthony A. Reyes, OSA and concelebrated by the some friars from the Province's Communities in Cebu. After the Mass, a short procession of the Ecce Homo image was held around the pilgrim center. Pilgrims, devotees, the Augustinian novices and friars joined the said procession.



Blessing of the New Tabernacle and the new retablo shrine of the Ecce Homo

Last February 28, 2019 during the 5:30 PM Mass, Cebu Auxiliary Bishop Dennis C. Villarojo led the blessing of the new tabernacle now placed at the lower portion of the central niche of the basilica's retablo mayor. Custom made by San Jose Religious Shop, the new tabernacle was donated by the mother and son tandem of Mrs. Rosalina N. Go and Mr. Mark Joel N. Go (Hermana Mayora and Hermano Mayor for Fiesta Señor 2018). The front design of the new tabernacle features the old logo of the Order which shows the restless heart of Saint Augustine pierced by an arrow.

After the Post Communion Prayer, Bishop Villarojo also blessed the new retablo shrine of the Ecce Homo at the right side of the basilica's sanctuary. The image of the Ecce Homo was then transferred to this new shrine by Fr. Pacifico C. Nohara, Basilica Rector assisted by Frs. Noel P. Cogasa, OSA and Ric Anthony A. Reyes, OSA. The new retablo shrine was also sponsored by the Go Family. By having its own retablo shrine, the friars at the basilica hopes that the devotion to the Ecce Homo will gain ground among the Cebuano faithful and to all the pilgrim who frequent the basilica.



The new tabernacle at the Basilica del Santo Niño was crafted by the San Jose Religious Shop (maker of quality religious items with main office at San Jose del Monte City, Bulacan) and was donated by Mrs. Rosalina N. Go and her son, Mr. Mark Joel N. Go (Hermana Mayora and Hermano Mayor for Fiesta Señor 2019). The tabernacle features the old logo of the Order which shows the restless and pierced heart of Saint Augustine while its podium features the coat of arms of Saint Paul VI, the pope who bestowed the title of minor basilica to the Santo Niño Church in 1965.

San Jose Parish Fiesta 2019

The Solemnity of Saint Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Protector of the Order of Saint Augustine, was celebrated last March 19, 2019. Saint Joseph is also the Patron Saint of the only Augustinian-ministered parish in the Archdiocese of Jaro, San Jose Parish. Jaro Archbishop Jose Romeo O. Lazo, DD, presided at the 5:30 PM Fiesta Mass on March 19, 2019. A procession around the main streets of the parish was held before the Fiesta Mass.

The Parish of San Jose was given to the Augustinians in 1868 in exchange for that of Jaro which was chosen to be the seat of the then newly-created Diocese of Jaro. Last year, San Jose Community celebrated the 150th Anniversary of Augustinian Presence in San Jose Parish.


